Barkway Market

The origins of Barkway Market can be traced back to 1270. Re-established in 1977, the famous Market has now become an annual Hertfordshire tradition.

The Market is an important fundraiser for numerous local charities and good causes including Barkway Village Hall, Barkway Church and Friends of Barley and Barkway School, Barkway Pre-school and the 7th Royston (Barkway) Scout Group. It is organised by a team of volunteers for Barkway Village Hall (registered charity no: 272922).

Book your stall now for Barkway Market. Hurry to avoid disappointment, because plots are limited and often sell out.

Stalls

Exterior stall:

Size: 3x3m (10 x10 ft) square plot (the size of a standard gazebo), please check that this plot size is adequate for your gazebo. Please note stallholders must provide their own table/s, chairs and gazebo.

Price: £35. Or £30 if booked before end of January 2023.

Interior stall (craft market):

Size: The space allocated will be for a standard 6ft table.

Price: £20 (£25 with a table).

Location: The craft market will be held in Barkway Church.

If you would like to have a catering stall please contact us in the first instance.

Terms and conditions

- 1. Booking forms must be sent by email or post and be accompanied by payment in full by bank transfer or cheque. You will receive confirmation of your booking if you provide an email address.
- 2. Details of time of arrival, route to be taken, parking arrangements etc will be provided nearer to the event date.
- 3. As the event is held on private land, it is a requirement that no signs are displayed showing allegiance to any political party or any other matter of a controversial nature. Please ask for guidance if in doubt.
- 4. Public liability: We have taken out event insurance which provides cover for our public liability. It is a requirement of the insurers that stallholders, too, have adequate insurance. So:
 - (a) Stallholders operating as a trade or business (including charities) must provide evidence of their public liability insurance (e.g. a copy of the certificate) at the time of making the booking.
 - (b) Private sellers must certify that they have suitable insurance. Many home insurance policies provide public liability insurance which may be sufficient please check. Any stallholder who did not have such insurance would be operating at their own risk.
- 5. Cancellation by you: Your booking fee is non-refundable and non-transferable.
- 6. Cancellation by us: We will make every effort to ensure that the event goes ahead and will only cancel in the event of severe weather, or for other exceptional reasons beyond our control. If cancellation is unavoidable, we will refund 50% of the booking fee. As a small charity, we need to retain 50% to help defray the significant expenses associated with mounting the event.
- 7. Data protection: Your name, email address and telephone number will be stored on a password-protected computer for the sole purposes of record-keeping, including for insurance purposes, and communicating with you about the Market. You may request removal of your details from the stallholders' mailing list at any time by emailing bookings.barkwaymarket@gmail.com.
